

# Useful addresses and info for a pleasant stay...:

**The tourist office** ... .6 Rue Rockefeller... at the end of the cathedral square. You will find there all the information on the free animations of the city, as well as, on weekends, tastings of small producers of champagne. <a href="https://www.reims-tourisme.com/">https://www.reims-tourisme.com/</a>

Our advice: go there at the end of the morning, there will be fewer people and the tastings will serve as aperitif!!

There is a magnificent **sound and light show on Reims Cathedral** every evening at 10 p.m. (except Mondays). It is not to be missed and it is free. Info and times: https://regalia-reims.fr/

# Closest supermarkets:

- A market of small local producers (fruits / vegetables / cheeses / meats and meats), is set up in front of your building (rue Simon) every Tuesday morning (from 6 am to 1 pm ..... remember to move your car).
- -Carrefour Market, at 84 rue Gambetta, 300 meters from the apartment (4 min walk) open until 8 p.m. (tel: 03 26 35 20 96)
- **Franprix**, 22 Esplanade Fléchambault, 400 meters (5 min walk), open until 8:30 p.m. (tel: +33 3 26 85 87 80).
- -The **best bakery** in the area ... and in Reims: "The bread cellar", 300 meters from the apartment towards the city center (before the crossroads market).

#### The nearest parks:

-Le Parc de Champagne....direction Pommery estate, it was created by the Marquis de Polignac for the well-being of its staff working in the cellars but also to mark Reims with its mark, it is located at 10 avenue du Général-Giraud.

**-Leo-Lagrange Park**, located near the FOOT stadium Auguste Delaune is the largest of the Reims urban parks (11.8 ha). Verzy is a small neighboring village (20min / 18 km) inhabited by many small producers of Champagne. The walk in the vineyards is already nice ... and the scythes are impressive. The future kings of France went there to meditate with the monks before their coronation....

-Walking on Epernay, (you can also go there by train), where You will absolutely have to go and see "the champagne avenue" which is classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and which is one of the main axes of the city of 'Épernay, often considered as its "most prestigious route", because it is the richest avenue in the World. It is in fact the seat of several large Champagne houses, including "Moët & Chandon" and "Perrier-Jouët" which have had a major role in the history of Epernay.

These will be our suggestions for a visit with the house "Mercier" and its famous visit to the cellars on the little train, or even "Castellane" at 63 avenue de champagne.

-A memorable outing: **the shell cellar** at Fleury la Rivière (24km) will make a lasting impression on your children! The father left the management of the vines to his son because he is passionate about basements ...
